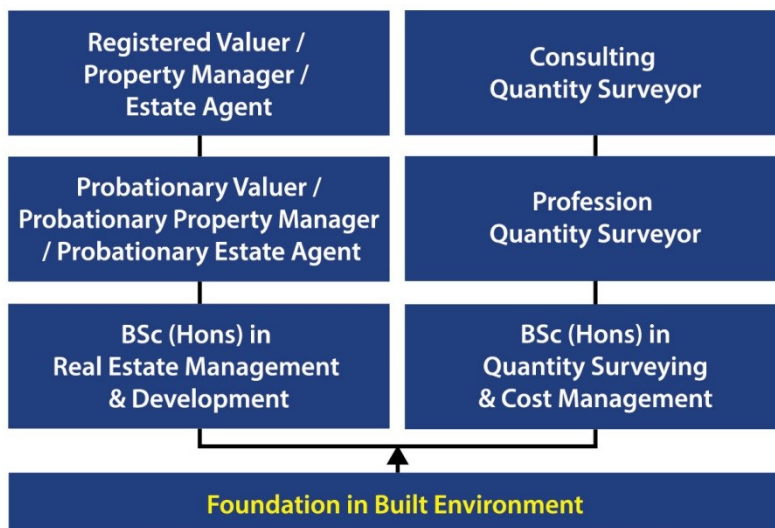
Programme Overview
